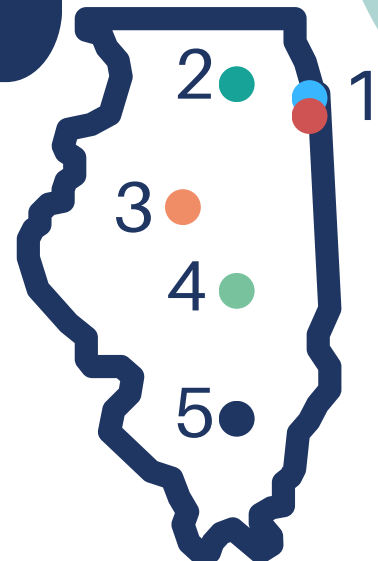
Benefits
